LOCAL PRACTICE

Members work on concerns of specific interest in Lancaster County. These issues may include working with the local judiciary on court procedures and facilities, improving judge-attorney communication, or addressing legislative issues of interest to local judges and attorneys.

FIELD DAY

This is the LBA kick-off event usually held on Columbus Day each year. The day consists of golf and is set up for participants at all levels of ability. Golf is followed by a social hour, dinner, and an awards ceremony. Field Day is a great opportunity for bar members to get out of the office and mingle with each other.

MEMORIAL SERVICE

In May of each year, the Lincoln Bar Association holds a memorial service in the Lancaster County District Court honoring those members of the local bar who have passed away during the preceding year. This committee plans and presents that program.

HISTORICAL

This committee compiles and preserves the history of the Lincoln Bar Association and its members, as well as plans clinics related to noteworthy trials or other law related events of particular interest to Lancaster County.

LAW DAY

This group coordinates with local schools to celebrate this nationally recognized Mat 1st event. Members work together to create a program for use by lawyers and judges at the school, typically working with the national Law Day theme. The Governor and Chief Justice have been regular participants in this community event.

NEWSLETTER

The LBA newsletter is published several times each membership year and contains articles and photographs of current and historical interest. This publication features local jury verdicts, and alimony awards, when available.

MEMBERSHIP

The membership committee is responsible for greeting members and handing out name tags at monthly meetings, submitting CLE credit information, and working to increase membership in the organization.
